Please keep in mind the guidelines so that the show may run smoothly and be enjoyable for everyone!

- Act must be approved by a parent or guardian
- Act must be 2 minutes or less
- Grades must perform within their scheduled show time (i.e., 1st grader cannot perform with a 4th grader)
- No lip-synching
- Music and lyrics (even background music) should be appropriate for school
- School administrators have the right to pull an act if considered inappropriate for school
